1. The committee reserves the right to cancel any classes or prize money due to insufficient entries.
2. The judges decision is final.
3. No claims entertained for the anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their animals or property in connection with or arising out of the show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant and their animal have suitable third party insurance and that they shall indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from any incident whatsoever.
4. No entry accepted without to correct fee.
5. Hats to current British Safety Standards must be worn at all times when mounted and handling a horse in the ring.
6. All ridden horses must be over 4 years old.
7. Mountain and Moorland, CHAPs and RoR entries must be registered with the prospective society.
8. Pony classes under 14.2hh and Horses over 14.2hh
9. Youngstock classes all ages taken from January the year of the Show.
10. Photos will be taken on the day and may be used on social media and for advertising
11. Stallion's over 2 must be show in a bit and be identified with a tail ribbon and Arm band at all times.

RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier Rules 2019

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered Horses, 4yrs and over, Mare and Geldings, Owned, produced and Ridden by an Amateur.

Riders must be 15yrs or Over on the first of January of the calendar year holding the classes, Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavasson noseband. Horses should be plaited, the series is open to AMATEURS ONLY- Those employed in racing will be allowed to compete, Class will be judged under 'Riding Horse' format without a type being taken into consideration.

Racing injuries and Blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series, this class is a qualifier for the RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series.

The judge will not ride at the qualifier but will ride at the final. The first three go forward to the final at the RoR Goffs UK National Championships at Aintree in August 2019. Rosettes 1st – 6th, Prizes 1st £40 plus RoR Jacket, 2nd £30, 3rd £20 and 4th £10

Amateur Definition – An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous: Engaged in breeding, Livery, Buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses (for the show ring) in a commercial capacity.

Horses must not have been stabled at the reside in a professional Produced/trainers Yard, Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a professional or trainer in the current or previous season and must not off received help from a profession /trainer in the current or pervious year. Horses must not have been ridden by a rider who has ridden for a professional producer or trainer, any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK).

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.
