

Schedule of Classes

Class 1: The Society Championship

Prizes: £8.50, £5.50, £3.00, £1.00 Entry 50p

This class is open to societies and associations, such as Gardening Clubs, Women's Institutes etc, as well as to families and individuals. It gives entrants the opportunity to demonstrate all-round skills and ability.

In order to enter this class, five items should be selected from the following schedule, with no more than two from any one section. These five selections then become one entry into this class.

The specialist judges will mark each item out of a maximum of 20 points. The entry scoring the highest combined points will win. In the event of a tie, preference will be given to the entry covering the most sections of the schedule.
