Conditions of Entry

- 1. The cattle and sheep sections are open to all cattle and sheep producers
- 2. Animals exhibited must have been the property of the exhibitor for the following periods prior to the show:
 - Cattle 4 months Sheep 3 months
- 3. ALL CATTLE TO BE PENNED BY 10.30am for judging to commence at 11.00am prompt. ALL SHEEP TO BE PENNED BY 11.30am for judging to commence at 12.30pm prompt
- 4. Parade in main ring
- 5. The exhibitor will be responsible for the correctness of the particulars on each entry form and any incorrect entry or misrepresentation will automatically disqualify the entry
- 6. The judges may decide not to award a prize if they consider the animal or animals exhibited have insufficient merit.
- 7. If a dispute arises it must be reported to the judge's steward and the matter referred to the Chairman of the Show Committee and a panel of judges whose decision shall be final.
- 8. All entries must be received not later than mid-day on 22nd August 2022
- 9. The winners shall hold all cups/shields for a period of 12 months. If a competitor shall win a cup/shield for the same class three years in succession that competitor shall be presented with a replica, except where a cup/shield is stipulated as being a perpetual cup/shield, which shall be competed for annually.
- 10. Exhibitors shall be responsible for the welfare and behaviour of the livestock they have entered.
- 11. Sheep are non-accredited only.
- 12. The Committee reserves the right to vary the order of composition of the schedule and decline any entry.
- 13. No responsibility will be accepted by the Committee or their stewards or other assistants for anything that may happen to exhibitors, their assistants or members of the public, their property or animals in connection with or arising out of this Show.
- 14. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor agrees to indemnify the Committee against any legal actions arising there from.
- 15. All females of all breeds except Dorset Horn, Polled Dorset and Finish Landrace to be entered are:
 - a. Non-pregnant (empty).
 - b. Have not lambed with 30 days prior to show
 - c. Not subject to procedures that change the seasonal breeding pattern.
